

Bridget Moore Biography

Bridget was born in 1960 in Whitstable Kent. She was educated locally, then at the age of 17 attended Medway College of Design for a one-year foundation course. This was followed by 3 years at Epsom School of Art studying Fine Art followed by 3 years at the Royal Academy Schools in the school of painting. On leaving her art education she was a recipient of the prestigious Elizabeth Greenshields Foundation prize.

Bridget taught an Adult Education Class in Beckenham for 4 years.

She has continued to paint and exhibit continually in many group and mixed shows since leaving Art School.

Painting in gouache but also oil and mixed media, she has always kept sketch books filled with notes, observations and drawings which form the basis of, and are integral to her work and way of working. Her work has been shown across the UK, also in Kentucky and California USA and in Qingdao, China where it is now held in a permanent collection.

She has exhibited in RA Summer Exhibitions, Sunday Times watercolour competitions, The Discerning Eye, and the Lynn Painter-Stainers Prize where she was a runner-up in 2006. She is a member of and shows work with the Royal Society of British Artists, the New English Art Club, the Royal Watercolour Society and the Small Paintings Group.
